Awarded to Cape May County students. Financial need considered.

Awarded to Cape May County students. Financial need considered.

Awarded to an Atlantic Cape Community College student.

### Newfield Bank Scramble 'Fore' Scholarships

Awarded to Cape May County students. Financial need considered.

### Melvin L. Newton Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating EOF student who is involved in campus or community activities and is transferring to a four-year college or university in New Jersey.

### Joe O'Connor 'Pay It Forward' Scholarship

Awarded to a Cape May County student who is a hardworking volunteer in the community.

### Scramble 'Fore' Scholarships

Awarded to a Cape May County student(s) with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Financial need considered.

### Sandy Steinberger Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a returning student with a non-traditional career goal. Submit a written statement demonstrating leadership ability. Minimum 2.5 GPA.

### John E. Stelman Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a sophomore who has demonstrated support to fellow students in their learning process. Minimum 2.8 GPA. Financial need.

### WIBCA/GEMS Memorial Scholarship Fund

Awarded to a Cape May County minority student.

### Edward James Yoa Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a full-time student with a GPA of 3.5 or higher. Must be a resident of Atlantic or Cape May County.

### ZONTA Club Scholarship

Awarded to a female student who is 25 years or older and raising children on her own, returning to college or attending for the first time with at least a 3.0 GPA and financial need.

## SCIENCE/SOCIAL SCIENCE

### Thomas C. Conover Memorial

For a graduating anthropology, biology or chemistry major continuing in a four-year science program. Merit only.

### Joyce Dana Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a female student likely to go into research in any science field who demonstrates a good academic record.

### Joseph T. McGrellis, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to student majoring in science or nursing.

### Dr. Oliver Henderson Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an Atlantic or Cape May County student with non-developmental credits in math/science at Atlantic Cape and/or NJ Marine Science Consortium. Merit only.

### Ralph A. Russell Memorial Scholarship

Award to Cape May County student studying math or science.

### Science/Math Division Award

Awarded to second-year math/science student with minimum 3.25 GPA in major.

### Ruth L. Williams Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an Atlantic Cape EOF graduate seeking a bachelor's degree in the social sciences.

## SPECIAL NEEDS

### Boardwalk Regents Club Scholarship

Awarded to a special needs student or a student pursuing a career working with disabled students.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Pick up an application from the Financial Aid Office and other campus locations or download from [www.atlantic.edu](http://www.atlantic.edu).
- Complete the packet and return to Financial Aid before the deadline.
- Complete the Financial Need Statement in the packet if you wish to be considered for all scholarships.
- You will be considered for all scholarships for which you qualify. The Scholarship Committee meets in April to determine the recipients of each scholarship and award.
- You are encouraged to apply even if your major is not listed.
- Many scholarships are open to students in all areas.
- You will be notified in May whether you receive a scholarship or not.
- All recipients will be honored at a ceremony in May.

## SCHOLARSHIP Q & A

### Where do the funds for the scholarships come from and how are they distributed?

Scholarships are donated to or raised by Atlantic Cape Community College and the Atlantic Cape Foundation. The Scholarship Committee chooses recipients from the scholarship applications.

### When are scholarship applications available?

Scholarship applications for all students are available in November in the Financial Aid Office and other buildings on all campuses. These applications are for scholarships for the following fall/spring academic year.

### What are the criteria for the scholarships?

The criteria vary according to the donor. Many require a minimum GPA, some specify financial need, some are for a specific major, etc.

### Do I need to apply for financial aid to qualify?

No; however, if you wish to be considered for a “need-based” scholarship, you must provide us with your financial information. Every student is encouraged to apply for financial aid.

### Is there a separate process for culinary applicants?

Yes and no. Several scholarship applications are available each year. The main application, available in November, is for all students. Culinary scholarships for the following fall semester are awarded based on this application. An application that is ONLY for culinary students is available in the fall, which is used to determine spring awards. Two additional scholarships are offered to culinary students only during the year.

### Are there any other scholarships I can apply for?

Yes. A binder is kept on the Financial Aid counter with blank applications. These are applications that are sent to us from other colleges, special interest groups, clubs, etc. Students are welcome to take applications and mail them to the address on the application.

### Following is a partial list of the scholarships and awards that are awarded annually:

#### ACCOUNTING

##### **N.J. Association of Public Accountants**

Awarded to a second-year accounting major who has completed 32 credits. Merit only.

##### **Nicholas Rettino Memorial**

Awarded to an accounting major who demonstrates financial need. Must have a GPA of 2.75 or better.

##### **William R. Conn Memorial**

Awarded to a second-year, full-time accounting student with a GPA of 3.0 or better.

#### ART/STUDIOART

##### **Art Club Achievement Award**

Awarded to a full- or part-time studio arts major with a GPA of 3.5 or higher. Financial need not considered.

##### **Marion White Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to a returning Atlantic or Cape May County student with minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference given to a studio arts majors.

## BUSINESS/COMMUNICATION

##### **Baucus & Company Scholarship**

Awarded to Cape May County student majoring in business.

##### **Helen Dilks Eshbach Scholarship**

Awarded to full- or part-time Atlantic or Cape May County students majoring in business with a minimum 2.9 GPA with financial need. Transferable.

##### **Andy J Scholarship**

Awarded to a full-time student majoring in business. Financial need preferred.

##### **Libby Demp Forrest Moore Memorial Writing Scholarship**

Awarded to a student interested in a career in journalism or writing. Financial need preferred.

##### **Marsha S. Popick Foundation Scholarship**

Awarded to a part-time communication major. Emphasis on academic performance.

## CHILD DEVELOPMENT/CHILDCARE

##### **Tanya Smith Memorial Child Care Scholarship**

Awarded to a returning child development/child care major with a GPA of 2.5 or better.

## COMPUTERS

##### **Terence Hutchison Memorial Award**

Awarded to a returning student with minimum 2.5 GPA in computer courses. Demonstrated interest in computer science/technology.

## CRIMINAL JUSTICE

##### **Jamie Crescenzo Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to a full-time criminal justice major who resides in Atlantic or Cape May County. Financial need preferred.

##### **Nate Allen Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to a culinary student.

##### **Atlantic Cape Community College Restaurant Gala Scholarship**

Must have completed five culinary courses and be recognized as outstanding in attendance and ethics. Financial need.

##### **Atlantic City Hotel and Lodging Association Culinary Scholarship**

Awarded to a student with minimum 3.0 GPA, involved in student activities and displays leadership qualities. Student must live or work locally and be in the culinary field.

Awarded to a culinary student.

Awarded to a culinary student.

Awarded to an Atlantic City resident majoring in hospitality studies.

##### **George C. Donaghue Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to a second-year, full-time hospitality management major, minimum 2.5 GPA, Atlantic or Cape May County resident.

##### **Howard Persina Scholarship**

Awarded to a hospitality major with a minimum 3.0 GPA and a desire to work in the Atlantic City area upon graduation.

For a female Atlantic or Cape May County resident, age 30 or older, enrolled in an allied health major with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need preferred. Transferable.

##### **Atlantic City Soroptimist Scholarship**

Awarded to a female health care major, preferred nursing major and Atlantic City resident. Demonstrated community service, good academic background and financial need.

##### **Colonel John L. and Ruth M. Lee Scholarships**

For nursing and allied health students. Atlantic County resident and high school graduate, second-year student with financial need and scholastic ability.

##### **James D. Schofield Scholarship**

For a nursing student in clinical portion of the program with minimum “C” average and financial need.

##### **Joan Fineran Nursing Scholarship**

Awarded to a nursing student from Atlantic or Cape May County. Financial need considered.

##### **Nursing Program Scholarship**

Awarded to a nursing student.

##### **Joy Eshbach Roehnert Scholarship**

Awarded to a female Atlantic or Cape May County resident, age 30 or older, nursing major, minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need preferred.

##### **Margaret M. Wright Scholarship**

For a second-year nursing student with a GPA of 3.0 or better, recommended by nursing faculty. Cape May County resident preferred.

##### **SouthShore Foundation Health Education Scholarship**

Awarded to a graduating student who is transferring to a baccalaureate program in a health-related field.

##### **SouthShore Foundation Scholarship**

For allied health and nursing students in clinical portion of the program, minimum 2.5 GPA. Two faculty recommendations. Merit only.

##### **Visiting Nurses Association of A.C. Scholarship**

For a nursing student in clinical portion of the program with minimum “C” average and financial need.

##### **Walter Russell Eshbach Scholarship**

Awarded to allied health majors with financial need.
