

## LEED Green Associate and Vegetative Green Roofing Systems Program

*Participants who have knowledge in roofing, construction, electricity or plumbing are encouraged to join this career training program.*

This program provides students with LEED Green Associate Certification, Green Building Today Certificate of Completion from Atlantic Cape Community College, and CEUs from the National Roofing Contractors Association (NRCA). The **LEED Green Associate Certification** denotes knowledge and understanding of green design, construction and operation, and carries the commitment to energy efficiency and green building. This comprehensive course prepares students to take the U.S. Green Building Council LEED Green Associate Exam and provides students with knowledge about green roofing systems. Course includes all materials, study guides and one LEED Green Associate exam fee. This program includes the following topics:

- **NRCA’s Vegetative Roof Systems (7.5 hours):** This program is geared specifically to roofing professionals and those interested in learning about terminology, benefits, waterproofing membranes and construction details, growth media and vegetation, code compliance and business and legal issues associated with vegetative roof systems. **Accreditation:** 0.75 CEU, 7.5 AIA/CES LUs, (SD credit), 8 hours of Florida CILB credit (Provider No.: 0000936, Course No.: 0608240)
- **Green Building Today (7 hours):** Prerequisite module for taking the LEED Green Associate Exam; provides an in-depth view of design and construction of green high-performance buildings and explores up-to-date and future building systems, technologies and materials. Course will offer insight to more effectively achieve your client’s and company’s goals.
- **Green Building Prep and Review (18 hours):** This intensive 18-hour course will help professionals become conversant on green design and building technologies—new and old—and their application to new construction and existing building operations and maintenance. This course prepares professionals to take the LEED Green Associate exam and provides affordable ideas to implement in existing buildings immediately. Participants review and discuss topics from Green Building Today and apply them to hypothetical scenarios relative to green building construction and design.
