Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program

FACT SHEET (KEEP FOR YOUR RECORDS)

The Educational Opportunity Fund Program (EOF) is a state sponsored program which provides academic and financial support to selected, eligible students who have demonstrated the potential for success in college. Since EOF is not an entitlement program, even if you meet the eligibility requirements, only a limited number of students will be selected for participation.

Eligibility

The following requirements must be met in order to be considered for the Educational Opportunity Fund Program:

1. You must have received a high school diploma, a New Jersey high school equivalency diploma, or a GED certificate by the time you register for college.
2. If you are a foreign national, you must hold an Alien Registration Card Form I 151, indicating that you are an eligible non-citizen.
3. You must be a New Jersey resident for at least one year.
4. Income guidelines:

You must also:

1. Be admitted to ACCC and registered as a full-time (12 or more credits) student.
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
3. Complete the EOF application

Services

All EOF students can receive up to \$1050 per academic year, academic advisement, monitoring of academic progress, personal counseling, career planning, transfer advisement, workshops/seminars, summer classes, development of an academic plan and transfer admission fee waivers.
