

Multiple Measures Direct Placement Guidelines

English Placement Standards

Students can be placed directly into ENGL101 by one of the following means:

- 1) SAT/ACT score (see catalog for current numbers)
- 2) HS GPA (overall GPA of 75%, 2.5 or C **AND** a GPA of 80%, 3.0 or B in Junior and Senior English classes)
- 3) Accuplacer Score

Students can be placed into ENGL101/ALP by one of the following means:

- 1) HS GPA (Overall GPA of 70%, 2.0 or C- and GPA of 70%, 2.0 or C in Junior and Senior English classes)
- 2) Accuplacer Score

Math Placement Standards

Incoming Students who have Graduated high school in the past 5 years.
Students who have graduated more than 5 years ago must take the Accuplacer

Students can be placed directly into College Level Math by one of the following means:

- 1) SAT/ACT or Accuplacer Score

Math 121: Applications of Math;
Requires HS GPA of 2.5, 75%, or a GED

Math 122: College Algebra;
Requires grade in HS Algebra II of 80%, or B (3.0)

Math 220: Statistical Methods;
Requires HS Statistics of grade of 80%, or B (3.0) or HS GPA of 2.5, 75%, or C+

Math 150: Pre-Calculus;
Requires HS Pre-Calculus grade of 80%, or B (3.0)

Math 155: Calculus I;
Requires HS Calculus grade of 80%, or B (3.0).

Documentation Requirements

In order to meet these requirements, Atlantic Cape will accept official and non-official transcripts from public, private High Schools or homeschools or GED certificates.

If above standards are not met, student must take Accuplacer for placement.

NJ Stars students without SAT/ACT scores that exempt them will be required to take the ACCUPLACER

Students whose native language is not English are required to take the Oxford Online ESL placement test.
